ACTIVITIES & GROUPS

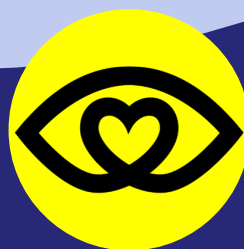
We host a variety of support groups including:

- Kitchen Skills Group (monthly)

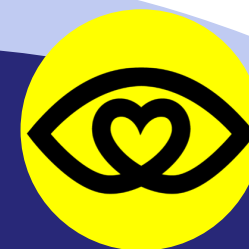
We also run the Stepping Forward course which is open to those who are newly registered or new to sight loss, to give advice regarding aids, benefits and employment support.
